What is the European Union?

- A group of 28 member states from all over Europe.
- The aim is to create a political and economic community across Europe.
- Currency: Euro
- Important principle: to open border policy – free to travel, work or live in other member states without needing a visa.

What is the Schengen agreement?

- The Schengen Agreement was adopted in 1985 between five nations and later expanded to include most continental European nations.
- No border controls within Schengen Agreement area. (no passport needed)
- Not all EU members are part of the Schengen Agreement (UK, Ireland did not sign it)

Who are/are not members of the EU?

- The EU consists of nearly half a billion people and covers the area of 4 million square kilometres.
- Countries must fulfil the Copenhagen criteria:
- Members must have a stable democratic government, respect for minorities and human rights, and a competitive and functional market economy.

Who is the leader of the European Union?

- Since its beginning, the EU has had a rotating presidency, member countries take turns being in charge for six months at a time. However the position is mostly symbolic.
- The EU consists of heads of state from all member countries, and they suggest issues to be talked about at meetings.
- The European Commission acts as the executive branch of the government and works directly with two legislative houses: The European Parliament and The Council of the European Union.
